YESTERDAY'S RECAP

The Chesapeake Baysox completed their third shutout win of the regular season with a 2-0 victory over Akron on Friday night. Starter **Nestor German** matched his career-high with 5.2 innings and four strikeouts. **Preston Johnson** threw 2.1 innings and **Gerald Ogando** remained perfect in save opportunities, notching his fourth of the season. **Anthony Servideo** accounted for both runs, collecting an RBI triple and scoring on a sacrifice fly in the second.

ENRIQUE ELECTRIFIES

OF **Enrique Bradfield Jr.**'s 10th inning two-run homer on Wednesday was not only his first homer of the season **but the first Baysox extra inning homer of the year and the first extra inning homer since September 6, 2023. The Orioles No. 3 prospect has now reached base in 16 of 20 games played to start the season. The 2023 first rounder missed 32 games from April 11 - May 19 due to a left hamstring injury.**

CREED CRUSHES

C Creed Willems celebrated his 22nd birthday on Wednesday. The Orioles No. 12 prospect is tied for 10th in the Eastern League in extra base hits (19), is 10th in total bases (78), is 12th in OPS (.811) and 12th in SLG (.467). Willems hit five homers in the month of May, which was tied for the fifth-most in the league.

RETZ CAN RAKE

C Adam Retzbach was one of the Eastern League's best offensive players in the month of May. The 24-year-old posted the third-best on-base percentage (.457) and the sixth-best batting average in the league (.327). Retzbach has reached base in 13 of his last 15 games.

TEACH ME HOW TO DOUGIE

OF **Doug Hodo** is tied for seventh in the Eastern League in walks (28) and 15th in OBP (.365). After a slow start to the season, Hodo's bat heated up in the month of May, posting a slash line of .294/.380/.426 with three doubles, two homers and eight RBI.

WALK THIS WAY

C Silas Ardoin leads the Eastern League in walks (37). Ardoin drew the most walks in the league in the month of April with 18. Last season, he drew 47 walks in 104 games.

BULLPEN BEASTS

Chesapeake's bullpen holds a 2.81 ERA, which is third-best in Double-A and fifth-best in MiLB. Baysox relievers have punched out 281 hitters, which is third-most in all of Double-A and the most in the Eastern League.

ONE RUN WONDERS

Chesapeake has won 13 one-run games this season - which is tied for the most in the Eastern League along with Binghamton. The Baysox have played 22 one-run games this season, which is second-most in the Eastern League behind Reading (25).

A REMATCH AGAINST THE RUBBERDUCKS

The Akron RubberDucks enter this week with a 34-17 record, which is tied for the best record in the league. The Double-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians are coming off a series victory in Somerset and have won nine of their last 12. Akron won four of six in Bowie in the most recent series meeting May 13 - 18. The RubberDucks roster features two active members of the Guardians Top 30 prospect list (per MLB.com) - IF Angel Genao (No. 4), C Cooper Ingle (No. 8) and RHP Austin Peterson (No. 29).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

LHP Rodney Boone will make his 11th start of the season for the RubberDucks. The 25-year-old is coming off one of his shortest starts of the season on Sunday in Somerset where he pitched only 3.2 innings and allowed three runs on four hits and three walks in the loss. The former 8th round pick in 2021 has faced the Baysox twice in his career and holds a 7.71 ERA against them.

Recorded 13 strikeouts in final High-A start before earning promotion to Double-A

2025: Promoted to Double-A Chesapeake on 6/3. Started season in High-A Aberdeen. Made nine appearances (eight starts) and posted a 5.12 ERA with 67 K over 38.2 IP and 14 BB. At time of promotion, led South Atlantic League in strikeouts. Punched out a career-high 13 batters over a career-high 6.0 innings on 6/1 @ BRK, his final start at High-A. Struck out 10 or more batters in three of his nine outings. Recorded a 3.13 ERA with 45 K over 23 IP in his final five starts with Aberdeen.

COACHING STAFF

ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

Roberto Mercado returns for his second season as Baysox Manager in 2025 after completing his first year at the Double-A level last season. The 17th manager in franchise history, he led the Baysox to a 62-75 overall record, oversaw 18 player promotions to Triple-A and coached two former Baysox who would go on to make their Major League debuts in the same season. The New Britain, CT native also managed the Surprise Saguaros of the Arizona Fall League this past offseason, where he led them to a league-best 18-10 record and a Fall League Championship Game appearance.

Before the Baysox, Mercado spent two seasons as manager of the Aberdeen IronBirds - the Orioles' High-A affiliate. Mercado received the Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award in 2022 by the Orioles.

Prior to joining the O's, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut and served as Dean of Students for over 18 years.

JORDIE HENRY

Pitching Coach

Jordie Henry enters his first season as Baysox Pitching Coach in 2025 and his third season as a member of the Orioles' system. Previously, Henry served as the pitching coach at High-A Aberdeen where his staff recorded 1,357 strikeouts last season – 2nd-most in the South Atlantic League and 2nd-most in IronBirds franchise history. Before joining the Orioles, Henry was the Director of Pitching at Prime Sports Performance in Baltimore – a private athletic development training facility. He also worked as a pitching coach and instructor at the high school and summer collegiate levels. Henry pitched collegiately for four seasons at Wayland Baptist University.

JOSH BUNSELMEYER

Hitting Coach

Josh Bunselmeyer returns for his second season as Baysox Hitting Coach in 2025 and his sixth as a member of the Orioles' system. He joined the Baysox as hitting coach in 2024, after filling the same role for the Orioles' Single-A affiliate, the Delmarva Shorebirds, in 2023. He spent the previous three campaigns as a hitting coach in both the Florida Complex League and Dominican Summer League. Bunselmeyer played three seasons in the Independent Frontier League following a collegiate playing career at St. Louis University.

Fundamentals Coach

CHESAPEAKE OYSTER CATCHERS



For select home games, the Chesapeake Baysox will take the field as the Chesapeake Oyster Catchers as a tribute to the Chesapeake Bay's rich heritage and thriving ecosystem.

Inspired by the American oystercatcher, the prominent patterned shorebird can be found along the Chesapeake Bay year-round. With its bold black-and-white plumage, orange beak, and knack for hunting shellfish, the oystercatcher is a symbol of strength and ingenuity—qualities that define both the Chesapeake region and its passionate baseball fans.

The Oyster Catchers name also pays homage to the Chesapeake Bay's rich maritime traditions and oyster restoration efforts, celebrating the region's deep connection to its waters.

CANGREJOS FANTASMAS DE CHESAPEAKE



The Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake (Chesapeake Ghost Crabs) are a part of MiLB's "Copa de la Diversión™" or "Fun Cup™"- a season-long event series specifically designed to embrace the culture and values that resonate most with Minor League Baseball™ teams' local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identiy came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.

BOWIE PIT BEEF



The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Chesapeake Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland.



Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s.
