PERDOMO BOBBLE NIGHT: Tonight, the D-backs celebrate the new City Connect Serpientes uniforms with a must-have **Geraldo Perdomo** Bobble presented by Chas Roberts for the first 20,000 fans.

NATIVE AMERICAN RECOGNITION DAY: Tomorrow's Native American Recognition Day kicks off the 25th annual D-backs Inter-Tribal Youth Baseball & Softball Tournament, both presented by Talking Stick Resort, and features pregame parade 1,100 young baseball and softball players, Salt River Pima-Maricopa Indian Community President Martin Harvier throwing the ceremonial first pitch, recognitions of Arizona's Tribal Royalty Contingent, former Miss Salt River Isabella Dockerty singing the National Anthem and the Salt River Fire Department Honor Guard serving as Color Guard along with extravagant performances from drum groups, dancers and vocalists as well as art displays and educational exhibits.

INTER-TRIBAL YOUTH BASEBALL & SOFTBALL TOURNEY: The D-backs one-of-a-kind 25th Annual Inter-Tribal Youth Baseball & Softball Tournament presented by Talking Stick Resort, and generously supported by Resolution Copper and Nike, is Monday, June 2-Thursday, June 5 at Salt River Fields at Talking Stick.

The only tournament of its kind in Major League Baseball brings emerging talent from rural tribal communities to the big stage as 1,100 athletes across 75 teams representing 20 tribes spanning across Arizona, New Mexico, California and Oklahoma compete over 4 days.

LAST GAME: The D-backs lost 9-7 vs. Nationals last night.

- **Josh Naylor** had 2 singles to extend to an 8-game hitting streak and has 2 hits in each of his last 3 games.
- **Lourdes Gurriel Jr.** had 2 singles extend to a 7-game hitting streak, including 5 multi-hit efforts.
- **Geraldo Perdomo** had 2 RBI in his first start batting third in the lineup.
- **Pavin Smith** went 2-for-4 with a double and 2 RBI.
- **Eugenio Suárez** went 2-for-4 with a double and RBI.
- **Ketel Marte** went 1-for-3 with 2 walks.

TIMELY ANNIVERSARY WITH NATS: On this day in 2008, the D-backs and Nationals played a 1-hour, 52-minute game, the fastest 9-inning game ever @ Chase (second fastest in franchise history)...Brandon Webb tossed a complete game shutout with 8 strikeouts and 0 walks, while the offense hit 4 solo homers - 2 by Mark Reynolds and 1 apiece by Chris Young and Justin Upton.

VS. NATS: The D-backs are 9-4 in their last 13 games since June 6, 2023, slashing a combined .325/.381/.489 and outscoring them 83-49.

- At home, are 5-2 in their last 7 games and 7-3 in their last 10 games.
- **Corbin Carroll**, in 16 career games, is hitting .375 (21-for-53)/1.330 OPS with 4 doubles, 2 triples, 5 homers, 11 RBI, 9 walks and 5 stolen bases, including an 8-game hitting streak (May 5, 2023-June 19, 2024).
- **Ketel Marte** has a 6-game hitting streak (.429; 9-for-21, 1.145 OPS) since June 20, 2024...has hit safely in 11 of his last 12 games since May 7, 2023, hitting .375 (18-for-48)/1.082 OPS with 3 doubles, 1 triple, 3 homers and 11 RBI.

- **Lourdes Gurriel Jr.**, in his last 13 games since May 6, 2023, is batting .420 (21-for-50)/1.113 OPS with 2 doubles, 3 homers, 7 RBI and 4 walks, including 8 multi-hit efforts.
- **Geraldo Perdomo**, in his last 11 games since June 6, 2023, is batting .359 (14-for-39)/.871 OPS with 3 doubles, 8 RBI, 6 walks and 3 stolen bases.
- **Alek Thomas**, in 12 career games, is batting .333 (12-for-36)/.924 OPS with 2 doubles, 3 triples and 7 RBI.

STREAKING SNAKES: **Ketel Marte** has a season-high 10-game hit streak, batting .350 (14-for-40)/1.083 OPS with 2 doubles, 3 homers, 5 RBI and 6 walks.

- **Josh Naylor** has an 8-game hit streak, batting .333 (11-for-33)/.848 OPS with 1 double, 1 triple, 1 homer and 6 RBI.
- **Lourdes Gurriel Jr.** has a 7-game hit streak, batting .429 (12-for-28)/.916 OPS with 1 double and 3 RBI.

TRENDING HOME BATS: **Josh Naylor** has reached base safely in his last 11 home games, hitting .341 (14-for-41)/.836 OPS with 2 doubles, 1 homer, 5 RBI, 2 walks and 2 stolen bases, including multi-hit efforts in his last 3 games.

- **Ketel Marte** has hit safely in 7 of his last 9 home games, batting .367 (11-for-30)/1.313 OPS with 1 double, 4 homers, 7 RBI and 7 walks.
- **Pavin Smith**, in his last 8 home games with runners on base, is hitting .412 (7-for-17)/1.033 OPS with 3 doubles and 4 RBI.

MAY MASHER: **Ketel Marte** has hit a career-high 8 homers in May, also his most for any career month (prev: 7 in May 2019; 7 in June 2019, 2023, 2024; 7 in July 2024)...the last D-back to hit 9 homers in May was Christian Walker in 2022.

- Marte is tied for fourth in May homers in the NL (also: Matt Olson/ATL and Gavin Sheets/SD), behind Shohei Ohtani/LAD (15), Kyle Schwarber/PHI (10) and Pete Crow-Armstrong/CHC (9).

HITS IN BUNCHES: D-backs have recorded 10+ hits in 4 of their last 6 games (since May 24).

- Since May 13, the D-backs' 9 games with 10+ hits are most in MLB, ahead of the Cubs (8) and Reds (8).

SNAKES POWER TANDEM: The D-backs are the only team in the Majors with multiple players with 15+ homers in **Corbin Carroll** (16) and **Eugenio Suárez** (15).

- Carroll and Suárez are the third duo in franchise history with 15+ homers in the team's first 57 games to start a season [also: 2001-Luis Gonzalez (22) and Reggie Sanders (16); 1999-Jay Bell (17) and Matt Williams (16)].
- Carroll is the first D-back (8th all time) with 16+ homers in the team's first 57 games since Paul Goldschmidt in 2015 (16).

MAY-JORS LEADERS: Among all teams in May, the D-backs rank in extra-base hits (1st, 94), total bases (1st, 423), hits (T-1st, 250), OPS (3rd, .788), SLG (3rd, .454), OBP (4th, .334) and homers (T-4th, 37).

NEXT STARTER: RHP CORBIN BURNES (3-2, 2.72)

- In his 5 home starts, is 2-0 with a 1.72 ERA (6 ER in 31.1 IP), 12 walks and 32 strikeouts.
- Went decisionless in his lone career start vs. Nationals on Sept. 16, 2023 (ND; 4 ER in 5.2 IP, 3 BB, 9 K).
