**SO FAR SUMMARY:** Before last night's suspension:

- **Ketel Marte** (solo, 12) and **Geraldo Perdomo** (2-run, 7) hit back-to-back homers in the third inning.
- Tim Tawa is 2-for-2 (2 singles).
- **Eduardo Rodriguez**, in his first start off the injured list, allowed 2 runs in 5.0 innings.

**SUSPENDED, THEN DEFENDED:** Last night was the third suspended game in team history.

 The D-backs are 2-0 in completed suspended games... their last suspended game was also @ Reds in 2021 [Elias Sports Bureau]:

April 20, 2021 @ Reds (suspended in Top 8 due to rain), resumed April 21, 2021 - D-backs won 5-4: Zac Gallen started the game (ND; 3 ER in 5.2 IP, 6 K).

July 18, 2001 @ Padres (suspended in Top 3 after a pair of electrical explosions knocked out the LF lights of Qualcomm Stadium), resumed July 19, 2001 - D-backs won 3-0: Randy Johnson, in his 10th career relief appearance, had 16 strikeouts with 1 hit allowed over 7.0 innings after he took over for Curt Schilling (0 ER in 2.0 IP).

**LAST GAME:** On Thursday, the D-backs scored 7 unanswered runs in the ninth inning to win 11-10 @ Braves.

- Was the second sweep of the season and third alltime 3-game sweep @ Braves (also: April 16-18, 2019 and May 6-8, 2016).
- **Eugenio Suárez** hit an eventual game-winning 2-run double in the ninth inning.
- **Ketel Marte** went 2-for-4 with a solo homer (11), 2 RBI and 2 walks and extended his season-high on-base streak to 18 games.
- Lourdes Gurriel Jr. hit a solo homer (9), to start the comeback and extend his season-high hit streak to 11 games.

**HOT START IN JUNE:** The D-backs' 4 straight wins are also a franchise-high-tying to start June (also: done twice before in 2024 and 2006).

 The D-backs franchise record to start any month is 6 straight wins, done twice: Sept. 1-6, 2017 vs. Dodgers & Reds and May 1-6, 2006 @ Rockies & Dodgers.

**ONE-OF-A-KIND COMEBACK:** Thursday was the D-backs' first win all-time when trailing by 6+ runs entering the ninth inning (previously 0-418).

• It was their largest comeback win since July 29, 2024 vs. Nationals (6 runs, won 9-8 after trailing 8-2 in mid sixth) and tied their second-largest comeback win in franchise history (12th time).

**STREAKING SNAKES: Ketel Marte**'s season-best 18-game on-base streak is tied for the fourth-longest active streak in the Majors (also: Nico Hoerner/CHC)...in that span is hitting .329 (23-for-70)/1.153 OPS with 2 doubles, 8 homers, 14 RBI, 12 walks and 4 hit-by-pitches.

- Lourdes Gurriel Jr. has a season-high 11-game hit streak, batting .381 (16-for-42)/.938 OPS with 2 doubles, 1 homer and 6 RBI, including 5 multi-hit games.
- **Gabriel Moreno** has a season-high-tying 7-game hitting streak, batting .370 (10-for-27)/.911 OPS with 2 doubles, 1 triple and 2 RBI.

**VS. REDS:** The D-backs are 8-2 in their last 10 games since Aug. 24, 2023…last season, the D-backs took the season series, 5-1, including a 3-game sweep @ Reds from May 7-9, 2024.

- **Ketel Marte** has a 9-game hitting streak @ Reds since June 7, 2022 at a .417 clip (15-for-36)/1.417 OPS with 2 doubles, 2 triples, 4 homers, 8 RBI and 5 walks, including 5 multi-hit efforts.
- **Gerardo Perdomo** has hit safely in 9 of his last 10 starts since June 7, 2022 at a .368 clip (14-for-38)/1.020 OPS with 1 double, 1 triple, 2 homers and 12 RBI.
- Reds since July 22, 2023 and is hitting .300 (6-for-20)/1.141 OPS with 9 RBI.
- **Josh Naylor** has a 6-game hitting streak since 2023 at a .381 clip (8-for-21)/1.033 OPS with 1 double, 1 homer, 8 RBI and 3 walks.

**WITH SNAKES ON BASE:** The D-backs, among all teams with runners on base since May 24 (11 games), are second with a .331 AVG and .919 OPS, fourth with 50 runs, fifth with 18 extra-base hits and tied for fifth with 7 homers.

- **Gabriel Moreno**, in his last 14 games with runners on base, is hitting .417 (10-for-24)/1.231 OPS with 2 doubles, 2 homers, 7 RBI and 3 walks.
- Lourdes Gurriel Jr., in his last 16 games with runners on base, is hitting .346 (9-for-26)/1.014 OPS with 1 double, 1 triple, 1 homer, 9 RBI and 5 walks.

**TRENDING ROAD BATS: Ketel Marte** has a 10-game road hitting streak, batting .375 (15-for-40)/1.418 OPS with 2 doubles, 7 homers, 11 RBI and 6 walks...reached base in 11 straight road games.

- Lourdes Gurriel Jr., has a 6-game road hitting streak, batting .348 (8-for-23)/.886 OPS...in his last 17 road games, is hitting .369 (24-for-65)/1.025 OPS with 6 doubles, 3 homers, 8 RBI and 7 walks.
